

- 1. Remove all items, such as boxes, dishes, silverware, and children's toys, from infested rooms and closets.
- 2. Wash pet bedding in hot water OR dispose of it in a sealable trash bag
- 3. Be sure to thoroughly mop all vinyl, tile, and wood floors; vacuum all carpeting and rugs, furniture, pet sleeping spots and dispose of vacuum filter with outside rubbish daily.
- 4. Remove/cover and turn off any animal tanks
- 5. Get any flea-infested pets treated by a professional veterinarian
- 6. Ensure people and pets are outside the home during the treatment
- 7. Wait 4 hours after the treatment is completed before re-entering your home
- 8. After treatment is completed, wash all eating surfaces with soap and water to ensure cleanliness.
